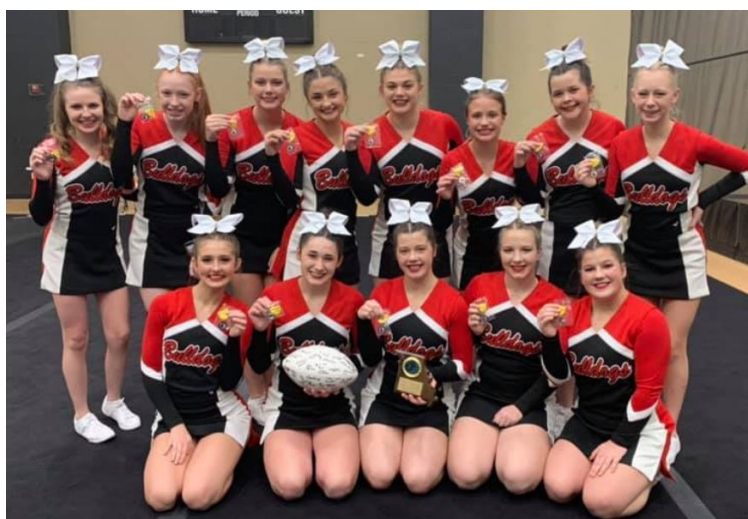

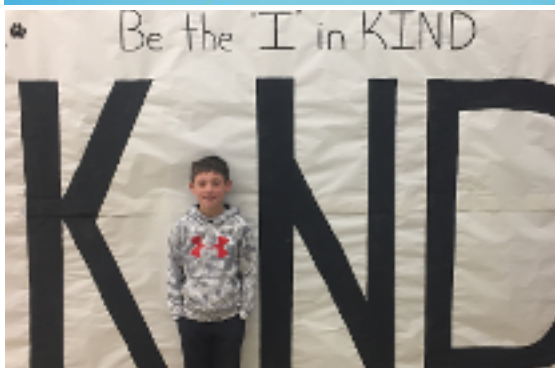


# Happy World Kindness Day!

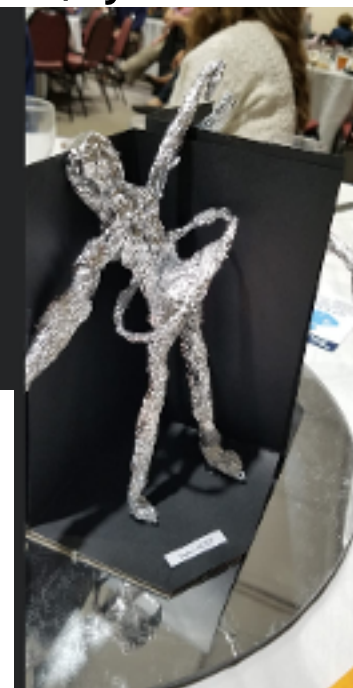
