This week, we are continuing our discussion on making inferences during reading. We will also be beginning our cursive handwriting unit. We will be working on two letters in cursive each week. We will be working through a new unit 10 spelling list. As I mentioned in some of your conferences last week, I feel that spelling, reading and writing are all connected so be sure to set aside some time each night to practice spelling words and read at least 10 minutes!

In math, we working our way through multiplication. We have laid down some of the foundational skills that help students establish strategies that can help them solve a multiplication problem, even if they haven't learned that fact quite yet in class. Be sure to ask your child to show you how to use repeated addition or how to draw picture of equal groups to solve a multiplication problem! We are also finishing up government in social studies and assessing this topic soon!
