Writing Activities

We are starting on our Persuasive / Opinion Writing. Opinion Writing is where we try to persuade others to think or understand our feelings about a topic. When writing, we begin with an introduction (the idea and our feelings towards it), give at least three reasons to explain why we feel the way we do about the topic. Then we complete our writing with a conclusion, restating our topic. Many students have started adding detail to "paint a picture in the readers mind" while writing!
