Content

We have been learning about the water cycle, how cloud form and the different types (formations) of clouds. We will be discussing weather patterns such as; rain, sleet, hail, snow, wind, tornados, thunderstorms, and hurricanes. Due to the March 6th tornado, I will not focus too much on the tornados due to anxiety. We will briefly discuss how they form and how to be safe.

Math

We have been working with standard and non-standard units of measure. We are currently working with rulers and how to measure using inches.



Keep practicing with addition and subtraction up to 20 to be able to "pop the answers off our tongue". This will help prepare your child for second grade!!!



Writing Activities

During our reading activities, we have focused on Fairy Tales. The stories we have read in class are based on old tales with a new spin. For example, "The Three Pigs and the Big Bad Wolf" is now rewritten as "The Three Little Aliens and the Big Bad Robot."
