Mental Health Awareness

How can you tell if your child's moodiness is actually depression, anxiety or something else? There are three things to consider when your assessing their moods.

- 1. <u>Severity</u>-Keep an eye on their emotions, whether it's a down mood, outbursts, crying or other symptoms.
 - 2. <u>Duration</u>-how long is the distressed mood lasting?
 - <u>Different areas of Life</u>- Is your child acting out at home and/or school?
