

Scholarships available to A+ Students

Although full A+ tuition benefits are only funded for Missouri community colleges and vocational/technical schools, some 4-year colleges in Missouri offer scholarships to students who have met the A+ requirements. These scholarships are determined by the colleges themselves and may or may not be offered at any time. **PLEASE CHECK WITH THE FINANCIAL AID OFFICE AT THE COLLEGE TO VERIFY OR LEARN ABOUT INCENTIVES THEY MAY OFFER FOR A+ STUDENTS.**
