Information and Guidelines

- * This is a one-time Scholarship in the amount of \$1250.
- * Must be High School Senior Graduating in the spring of 2022.
- * Applicants must be either a member of the Missouri Junior Cattlemen's Association and/or whose parents are members of the Missouri Cattlemen's Association
- * Applicants must be affiliated with the Lafayette County Cattlemen's Association.
- * Must plan to attend College, Junior College or Post Secondary Vocational Institution in the fall of 2022.
- * Applicants are responsible for filling out the application form.
- * Applicants must provide two letters of recommendation on or before the application deadline.
- * **Application Deadline is April 1st.**
- * Interviews will be conducted on Tuesday April 5th starting at 6pm at the Lafayette County Extension Office in Higginsville, MO. Applicants will be contacted with interview time.
ALL APPLICANTS WILL BE INTERVIEWED.
- * Scholarship recipients will be announced by May 1, 2022.
- * Feel free to make copies of the application and reference form as needed.
- * Scholarship recipient must forward a copy of the letter from the college or university confirming acceptance as a student. Mail the acceptance letter by July 1 to Hannah Copenhaver – Scholarship Chair at 705 Fairground Avenue, Higginsville, MO 64037

Selection of Scholarship will be based on the following criteria:

1. Actual application form 10 pts.
2. Scholastic ability 10 pts.
3. Involvement in agriculture related youth activities 20 pts.
4. Involvement in other community and school activities 10 pts.
5. Leadership activities 10 pts.
6. Personal interview 30 pts.
7. Letters of recommendation 10 pts.
8. **100 points possible**
