MAXINE JENKINS MEMORIAL ART SCHOLARSHIP



The Maxine Jenkins Memorial Art scholarship is open to all graduating senior class members from the Odessa R-VII High School who are continuing their education after High School, special consideration will be made for those students who are majoring in the fine arts (Music, Theatre, Fine Art, Etc). It is the intent of the scholarship to provide an opportunity for a determined, serious student to pursue further education of training at an accredited college or vocational school. Scholastic success and evidence of determination, commitment and a desire to succeed are the determining factors rather than class rank or ACT scores. One (1) scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$350.00.

Maxine Jenkins was a local accomplished artist who loved sharing her talent with family and friends. She specialized in oil, pastel and graphite portraits, having taken classes from the renowned artist, Harry Fredman. She worked as a commercial/graphic artist for thirty (30) years, retiring in 1995. In 2010, at the age of 79, Maxine combined her passion not only for art, but also for making new friends and began teaching art classes in Odessa. Maxine was also an active member of the Odessa Art Club.

The scholarship selection committee will be comprised of Executive Officers of Odessa Art Club, a family member and a high school counselor. The scholarship funds will be distributed directly to the business office of the selected college or vocational school of the recipient. All applications must be submitted to the Odessa R-VII High School Counseling office by April 14, 2022. Please submit a typewritten application. Please submit supporting documentation to show your fine art talents. Example: artist should submit 2-3 pieces of their work via print or CD; music students should submit a recording of their talents via CD; and theatre students should submit videos or programs of their productions.
